Angel Food is offering a Senior Box, which includes 10 perfectly seasoned, nutritionally balanced, fully-cooked meals that are heat and serve. The Senior Box sells for \$28.00 and includes Country Herb Chicken, Breaded Baked Fish, Spaghetti with Meatballs, Chicken and Rice, and Mesquite Chicken with 5 other meals included. 
